

Upload your poster for the digital poster exhibition

(Please read completely to get all the information)

The ePoster upload will be open in [congress portal m-anage](#) from **1 July 2022**.

ATTENTION: Only the speaker assigned to the abstract has the possibility to upload.

Below you will find guidelines for preparing and uploading your digital poster:

1. Preparing your presentation

- **Format:** Only ePosters in **PDF format** will be accepted.
- All ePosters must be 1-sided and created in **portrait format**.
- To ensure the best quality of the ePoster, we recommend that the PDF file is created in A0 format (841mm x 1189mm or 33.11 x 46.81 inches).
- In case you use Photoshop, you can see the resolution there, which should be at least 200dpi.
- Hyperlinks, animated images, animations and videos are not allowed and will not work.
- QR codes can be integrated.
- **Privacy:** It must be guaranteed that all content used in your ePoster can be displayed in the ePoster Lounge during and after the congress. If your ePoster contains confidential data, remove this data before uploading your ePoster to m-anage.

2. Log-in in [congress portal m-anage](#), open "Content Submission"

3. Preparing the audio

Here you will find the instructions on how to add an audio description to your ePoster online [or](#) upload an already produced recording.

ATTENTION: The audio recording must not exceed 180 seconds!

- Click on "Poster narration recorder & Upload" within the step "Poster narration".

1. Poster narration

With the recorder you can add a narration audio track to your poster.

Please note: If you make a change on the narration, you have to upload your poster again. Otherwise the system won't be able to recognize the new track.

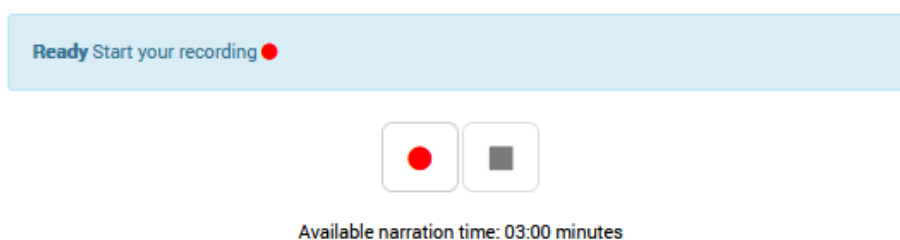
2. File transfer

Required file type: PDF MP3



- When you access the recorder for the first time, you will be prompted to allow access to your microphone at www.m-anage.com. You must allow access to your microphone in order to record a commentary via your browser. Make sure to use the latest possible browser version. Adobe Flash must be installed with at least version 12 for recording.
- You can use the recorder as soon as "Ready Start your recording" is displayed.

Narration recorder

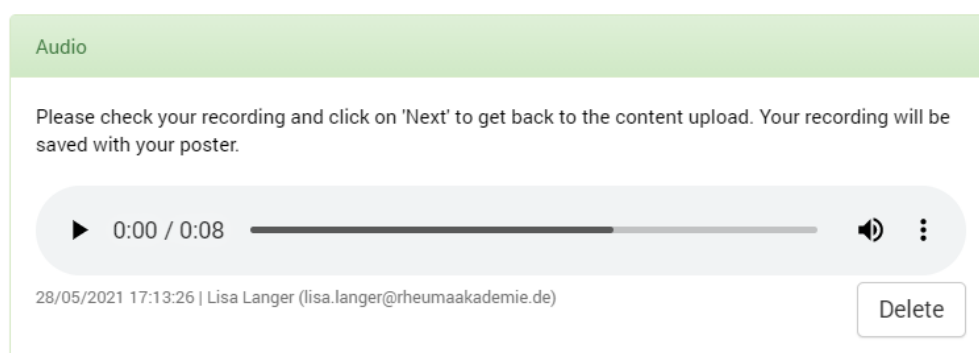


- Please press this button once to start your recording and again to stop the recording.

In case you want to re-record your audio description, please delete the file and repeat the previous steps.


➔ Upload an existing audio recording
